- 3. The ministry is focused on foster families.
- 4. The church provides an intergenerational culture of care, surrounding each foster family with "Villagers" trained to offer care, prayer, and community.
- 5. The ministry is woven into the outreach, evangelism, youth, and congregational care ministries of the church.
